A: What exactly do you mean?

How can I say it?

It's a feeling of closeness with others.

A: I'm still not sure I understand.

B: Hm ... How should I put it?

A: Do you mean like 'love'?

B: No, not exactly.

A: Is it friendship then?

B: It's kind of between friendship and love.

A: Okay, do you know how to say it in English?

B: I can't think of the right word.

A: But it is a good thing, right?

B: Sure it is.

A: Ok, then I'll take this shirt.

### 시간을 좀 벌려고 할 때 쓸 수 있는 표현

Can you save your question until after I finish?

발표를 끝낼 때까지 잠시 질문을 미뤄주시겠어요? (발표 중간에 질문을 할 경우)

Well, I'll have to think it over more.

그 질문은 좀 더 생각을 해봐야겠는데요.

### 질문에 대해 답을 영어로 표현하는 게 어려울 때 쓸 수 있는 표현

I'm not sure how to explain it in English.

영어로 어떻게 설명을 드려야 할지 잘 모르겠네요.

It's a little hard for me to explain it in English.

영어로 설명해 드리기가 좀 어려운데요.

### 질문에 대한 답을 모를 때 쓸 수 있는 표현

I don't know the answer to that.

그 질문에 대해서는 답을 잘 모르겠군요.

I'm not sure how to answer that.

답변을 어떻게 드려야 할지 잘 모르겠네요.
