Expression

흔히 들리는 표현

- ① Do you have any brothers or sisters?
- ② How many years apart are you and your brother?
- ③ Is your family in Seoul?
- ④ Do you live with your parents?
- ⑤ Do you visit your parents often?

내게 필요한 표현

- ① I live away from my parents.
- ② We are two years apart.
- ③ I used to live with my parents but I moved out last year.
- ④ My father passed away when I was young.
- ⑤ It's just me. (= I'm an only child.)

Understand

A: Do you have any brothers and sisters?

B: Yes, I have one sister.

A: How many years apart are you and your sister?

B: We are four years apart.

A: Do you both live with your parents?

B: My father passed away when I was young.

A: Oh, I see.

B: And I used to live with my mother, but I moved out last year.

A: What about your sister?

B: She still lives with my mother.

A: Do you visit your mother often?

B: Yes, I see her every other weekend.

A: I wish I could see my mother that often.

B: Isn't your family in Seoul?

A: No, I'm here by myself.

B: Oh, okay.

친인척(Relatives)에 대한 영어 명칭

한국말에서는 친인척에 대한 명칭이 잘 발달하여 있지만 영어는 아주 단순한 명칭만 있습니다. 예를 들어, 우리는 이모, 고모, 숙모, 큰어머니 등 여러 가지로 구분하는 명칭이 있지만 영어는 그냥 모두 aunt입니다. 아래에 한국 가 족 관계 명칭에 대한 몇 가지 영어 표현을 정리해두었습니다.

- 친할머니 my grandmother on my dad's side
- 외할머니 my grandmother on my mother's side
- 증조부 great grandfather
- 장인 / 시아버지 father-in-law
- 장모 / 시어머니 mother-in-law
- 시부모님 in-laws
- 처남 / 도련님 / 아주버니 brother-in-law
- 올케 / 시누이 sister-in-law

※ 시댁 / 처가 in-laws' house
