질문	가능한 대답
What's your nationality? 국적은요?	I am Korean.
Where are you from? 어디서 오셨어요?	I am from Korea.
Is this your first visit to America? 이게 첫 번째 미국 방문이신가요?	Yes, it is.
What brings you to the US? 미국 방문 목적이 뭔가요?	For sightseeing / traveling / business.
What's your final destination? 최종 목적지가 어디입니까?	New York.
Do you have a return ticket? 돌아갈 비행기표는 있습니까?	Yes, I do.
How much money are you carrying on you? 현금을 지금 얼마나 갖고 있습니까?	About five hundred dollars.
