Is there still space available for three people? 아직 세 사람 자리가 있을까요?

Can I pay when I get there? 거기 도착해서 요금을 지불해도 되나요?

How long will the tour last? 관광하는데 얼마나 걸리죠?

Do you run the tour on Sundays? 일요일에도 관광이 되는지요?

Do you also have half-day tours? 반나절 짜리 관광도 있나요?

Does the tour include lunch? 점심이 포함된 가격인가요?

공연 예약 / 문의 (Show / Performance / Concert)

Are there still seats available? 아직 자리가 남았나요?

Is it okay to bring small children? 유아를 동반해도 되나요?

Does your show open on Sundays? 일요일에도 공연이 있나요?

Can I have seats close to the stage? 무대 가까운 좌석으로 주세요.

Can I have an extra program? 프로그램 책자 하나 더 얻을 수 있을까요?

Will performers be signing autographs after the show? 공연 끝나고 싸인 받을 수 있나요?
